A Message from the President: Fr. Ian Boyd, C. S. B.

This newsletter brings you a brief report about the work of the Chesterton Institute during 2012, and an overview of the continuation of our work, upcoming programs and

projects which are reality with the support of Seton Hall University and our supporters.

The program of the Institute during 2012 has been a remarkable full and diverse one. Beginning the years with the sixth-annual Saints & Sleuths program and in February Professor Quinn spoke at Seton Hall to the Charles and Joan Alberto Italian Studies Institute on the subject of Chesterton in Italy. Later that month, Dr. Daniel Strait and I gave talks about "Chesterton and the Bible" to the American Bible Society in New



York City, and Mrs. Gloria Garafulich-Grabois addressed a conference in Madrid about "Chesterton: the Legendary Teacher." In March, Timothy Goeglein of Washington's Focus on the Family spoke at Seton Hall about the importance of Chesterton in the contemporary Protestant world. The subject of "Chesterton as a Journalist" was the theme of our annual conference in Italy and at the first conference in Malta. This past October, a series of conferences were held in Krakow and Warsaw on the theme "Chesterton and the Challenge of Poland." We finished the year with a conference in London celebrating the publication of Julia Stapleton's eight-volume edition of Chesterton's *Daily News* Articles and a conference in France at the Institute Catholique d'Études Superieurs.

May I make a direct appeal for your financial support for this on-going work? Though we receive occasional grants for specific projects, our yearly budget still requires the help provided each year by readers of **The Chesterton Review.** The subscribers of our journal form a fellowship, and for almost forty years, your donations—large and small—have enabled us to continue our work of bringing Chesterton's wisdom to a world which is more badly in need of it than it has ever been.

The Work of the G. K. Chesterton Institute for Faith & Culture

The G. K. Chesterton Institute, a not-for profit educational organization incorporated in the United States, Canada and Great Britain, is located at Seton Hall University, South Orange, N.J. Its purpose is to promote the thought of G. K. Chesterton and his circle and more broadly, to explore the application of Chestertonian ideas in the contemporary world. The Institute's work consists of conferences, lecture series, research and writing.

The Chesterton Review, founded in 1974, has been widely praised both for its scholarship and for the quality of its writing. Edited by Father Ian Boyd, it includes a wide range of articles not only on Chesterton himself, but on the issues close to his heart in the work of other writers and in the modern world. It has devoted special issues to C. S. Lewis, George Bernanos, Hilaire Belloc, Maurice Baring, Christopher Dawson, Cardinal Manning, the Modernist Crisis, J. R. R. Tolkien, Fantasy Literature, and a Special Polish Issue. As the interest in Chesterton continues to grow around the world, so does our publication which now publishes annual editions in Spanish, Portuguese, French and Italian.
