M.A., Instructional Design & Technology with a NJ Supervisor's Certificate (36 credits)

(Includes SHU certificate in Information Technologies)

Students who already have a Master's Degree and a minimum of three years teaching experience upon completion of the four (4) courses may apply to the State of NJ for a Supervisor Certificate.

The online Instructional Design and Technology (IDAT) M.A. with a concentration in New Jersey Supervisor's Certification prepares teachers, technology teachers, coaches, coordinators, and school library media specialists to meet the New Jersey State Department of Education 12 credit requirement for a supervisor's certificate while deepening their knowledge and expertise of 21st century digital technologies. Leaders in education engage in the theory and practice of supervision and curriculum while improving and strengthening their ability to effectively model and facilitate technology enhanced educational and management experiences. This continuous learning deepens professional knowledge, skills, and dispositions in organizational change, leadership, project management, and professional practice.

Teachers, technology teachers, coaches, coordinators, and school library media specialists seeking to become educational administrators such as district coordinators, directors or supervisors should apply for this degree program. To advance, in a public school setting, to a supervisory position it is necessary to acquire state supervisory certification. Completing the Instructional Design and Technology with a concentration in Supervisor's Certification M.A. program and a minimum three years teaching experience in a public or private school setting allows graduates to advance to general or specialized administrative positions in public schools.
