General Information

The deadline for registration is October 31st, 2023. Students who are not officially registered **will not** be permitted to take part in the Competition.

Payment: There is a **non-refundable** registration fee of \$15 per student registered. *Please note that payment is due before the day of the Competition.* Checks should be made payable to "S.H.U. Math Competition" and mailed to:

The Competition will begin promptly at 10:00am on November 18, 2023.

Lunch: Lunch will be provided for the students immediately following the Competition.

Awards: Monetary prizes will be awarded to the top-scoring students.

Winners will need to fill out and submit a W-9 form for tax purposes. This form will require either the student's social security number or tax identification number. Prizes cannot be awarded without this form.

Plaques will be awarded for the five highest team scores. The team score for each school will be based on the total of the three highest scores of the participants from that school. Every contestant will receive a certificate of participation.

Notification: Unofficial winners will be announced immediately following the luncheon (approximately 1:00pm). Official results will be mailed to competing schools along with certificates of participation. Plaques for the team awards will also be mailed.

Description of Examination: The 90-minute exam consists of 16 questions weighted, with respect to their degree of difficulty. The subjects covered include Algebra, Geometry, Trigonometry, Theory of Equations, Combinatorics, Probability and miscellaneous elementary topics in Mathematics. Calculators may **not** be used for the test. The grading of the judges is final.

COVID Policies:

- Masks are currently optional at the University, but this may change. If a mask mandate is put into effect, we will reach out to the teachers and let them know.
- Current University policy asks that individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 isolate for 5 full days from the date symptoms began. To stop or discontinue isolation, at least 5 full days must have passed since the onset of symptoms and at least 24 hours have passed since any fever went away without the use of fever-reducing medications (such as Tylenol or Ibuprofen) and other symptoms have improved. Individuals must continue to wear a well-fitting mask around others for an additional 5 days after leaving isolation.
